

## CONSENT FOR ORAL CONSCIOUS SEDATION

The following is provided to inform you of the choices and risks involved with having treatment under sedation. This information is not presented to make patients more apprehensive, but to enable them to be better informed concerning their treatment. The choices for anesthesia are: local anesthesia, oral conscious sedation and inhalation sedation (nitrous oxide), or a combination of the above.

The side effects of any conscious sedation are nausea, vomiting, amnesia, loss of consciousness and possibly even death.
